








Year one – animals including humans.



Subject Specific Vocabulary	
bird	A group of animals that is warm blooded, has a beak and special feathers.
fish	A group of animals that has scales and is cold blooded.
mammal	A group of animals that have hair, are warm blooded and produce milk.
reptile	A group of animals that have dry, scaly skin and are cold blooded.
amphibian	A group of animals that have smooth skin and lay their eggs in or near water.
vertebrate	An animal with a backbone.
invertebrate	An animal that doesn't have a backbone.

	A vertebrate is any animal that has a backbone.
	Carnivores are animals that feed on other animals and only eat meat.
	Herbivores are animals that feed on plants.
	Omnivores are animals that eat meat and plants.
	Classify means to group items and objects according to their properties and characteristics .
	Items can be grouped using simple prepared tables and sorting rings.
