


# Year One – Art: How can I make a mark?


	<p><b>Sticky knowledge</b></p>
	<p>An artist is a person who makes paintings or drawings as a profession.</p> <p>Art <b>appreciation</b> involves discussions around a piece of art looking at likes and dislikes</p>
	<p>Alma Thomas was born in Washington and was an <b>influential</b> African American artist. Alma Thomas used large, repeated dabs of colour, separated by white space. Alma Thomas uses bold colours to form simple, flat shapes, stripes, and fields of colour.</p>
	<p>Vincent Van Gogh was an <b>influential</b> painter. He was famous for his paintings such as Starry Night and Sunflowers. He painted portraits, self-portraits and landscapes.</p> <p>Van Gogh used bold expressive lines and thick paint to create his style. He used darker colours and started using lighter colours near the end of his life. He became famous after his death.</p>
	<p>Henry Moore was a British sculptor famous for his sculptures of people with bumpy forms and hollow spaces in their bodies. He used flowing, abstract shapes in his sculptures.</p>
	<p>Secondary colours are green, purple and orange.</p> <p><b>Tertiary colours</b> are made when you mix a primary and secondary colour together.</p>
	<p>Sketchbooks can help us explore and experiment, research and collect. Sketchbooks can show an art journey but can also help us reflect on our art.</p>
	<p>Malleable materials can be <b>manipulated</b> to sculpt art such as clay, wire and foil. Non-malleable materials can be joined to create new shapes such as cardboard, wood, metals.</p>

<b>appreciation</b>	Recognition and enjoyment of the good qualities of someone or something.
<b>representation</b>	The action of speaking or acting on behalf of someone or the state of being so represented.
sculptor	An artist who uses malleable materials, such as clay or playdough.
primary colours	Colours which can be mixed to make other colours.
<b>technique</b>	The way of doing something.
artist	A person who creates paintings or drawings.
<b>influential</b>	The power to change or affect someone or something.
<b>manipulate</b>	To control something in a skilful manner.

Enhancer Sticky Knowledge 

Design criteria lists the aspects which must be included in the design and product.

Safely means following instructions carefully so as not to hurt yourself or others

A product can be made stronger by using a stronger material (plastic rather than paper) or stronger joints (Sellotape rather than masking tape).
