The Bible	The holy book for Christians.
Old Testament	The first part of the Bible, which is also followed by Jews.
New Testament	The second part of the Bible which includes the teachings of Jesus.
Ten Commandments	A set of 10 rules that Christians follow in order to be good Christians.
chapter	The sections within the Bible.
verses	A group of sentences in the Bible.

 Sticky knowledge	
	The Bible is divided into the Old Testament, the New Testament and these are divided into chapters and verses.
	The Old Testament is Jewish Scripture.
	The Bible tells Christians what God is like. It also tells a 'big story' of God's relationship with human beings: God loves humans and created a wonderful world for people (creation); humans disobey God and go their own way (the fall), God sends his Son, Jesus (incarnation) to save people – bring them back to God (salvation).
	Christians believe that the Bible and the Ten Commandments are important because they tell them about how to live and why they should follow God.

**Key Belief:**

The Bible is seen as a source of authority and wisdom. Christians use the bible in church, private worship and prayer.



**Key Belief:**

The Bible tells Christians about God and his relationship with them.
