wrist		Joins your hand to your arm.
fingers		Parts of your hand.
knee		Let's your leg bend in the middle.
ankle		Joins your foot to your leg.
toes		Parts of your feet.
Senses		How we gather information about the world around us.
Sight		Being able to see with eyes.
Hearing		Being able to detect sounds with ears.
smell		Being able to detect scents with a nose .

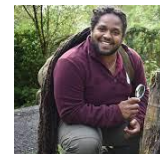
