Dear Parents/Carers,

Next term, Year 3 will be venturing back in time to the Stone Age where we will experience what life was really like and focus on our question; 'Is it survival of the fittest?'. We will be having a visitor into school who will deliver a workshop on the Stone Age and provide us with a range of materials and resources.

Also, Year 3 will be visiting Creswell Crags on Thursday 21st March 2024. The children will experience cave stories in the caves, a Stone Age safari, and those most important survival skills. This will allow the children to fulfil their learning on their enquiry – 'Is it survival of the fittest?'

On that day, we will be leaving school at 9:15am and will be back in time for the end of the school day. Your child will need to be in full "Team Pinxton" PE Kit and bring with them a packed lunch and water bottle.

If your child receives free school meals, school will provide a packed lunch for your child if you require one. The school office will send out a Microsoft Form by email on Monday 11th December 2023 for you to complete and let us know if you would like one ordering. This will need to be back with us by 29th January 2024.

In order for the trip to go ahead, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £23.00 per child. This includes the price of the coach, the entry to Creswell Crags, and towards the cost of the Prehistoric workshop and accounts for every child participating. This will need to be paid using Parent Pay from 16th October.

We have enabled you to spread the cost over three months or to pay in full. This will be set up on Parent Pay. A £5 deposit will need to be paid by Friday 27th October. Followed by £9.00 to be paid by Friday 24th November. Then a final payment of £9.00 to be paid by Friday 5th January 2024. The price and instalments will be discounted on Parent Pay if your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium.

Permission for this trip will also need to be given using Parent Pay. If we are unable to meet the costs of the trip through voluntary contributions, the trip will not be able to go ahead.
