








# Year one – Animals including humans.



Subject Specific Vocabulary	
carnivore	An animal that eats meat.
herbivore	An animal that eats plants.
omnivore	An animal that eats meat and plants.
bird	A group of animals that is warm blooded, has a beak and special feathers.
fish	A group of animals that has scales and is cold blooded.
mammal	A group of animals that have hair, are warm blooded and produce milk.
reptile	A group of animals that have dry, scaly skin and are cold blooded.
amphibian	A group of animals that have smooth skin and lay their eggs in or near water.
vertebrate	An animal with a backbone.
invertebrate	An animal that doesn't have a backbone.

	<b>Sticky knowledge</b>
	A vertebrate is any animal that has a backbone.
	<b>Carnivores</b> are animals that feed on other animals.
	<b>Herbivores</b> are animals that feed on plants.
	<b>Omnivores</b> are animals that eat meat and plants.
	Classify means to group items and objects according to their <b>properties</b> and <b>characteristics</b> .
	Items can be grouped using simple prepared tables and sorting rings.
