Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Calendula (marigold)	A type of garden plant with yellow flowers.
nasturtium	A type of garden plant with yellow or orange flowers.
rose	A type of garden plant with many different coloured flowers.
lavender	A type of garden plant with pink or purple flowers with a strong scent.
pansy	A type of garden plant with many different coloured flowers.
Evergreen	A plant that stays green throughout the whole year.
Deciduous	A plant that drops it's leaves at some point in the year.
season	The 4 parts of the year.
summer	The hottest season, it comes after spring and before autumn.
autumn	The season between summer and winter when the temperature slowly <b>decreases</b> .
winter	The coldest season, it comes after autumn and before spring.
spring	The season between winter and summer when the temperature slowly <b>increases</b> .
Garden plant	A plant grown in a garden by people.

	<b>Sticky knowledge</b>
	<i>Nasturtium calendula (marigold), rose, lavender and pansy</i> are types of garden plants.
	To know that summer days are the longest.
	To know that summer is usually the warmest season.
	To know the summer months are June, July and August.
	<b>Evergreen</b> trees have leaves throughout the year so are always green. For example: yew, pine and holly.
	<b>Deciduous</b> trees are trees that shed their leaves once a year, usually during the season of Autumn. For example: sycamore, oak and beech.
